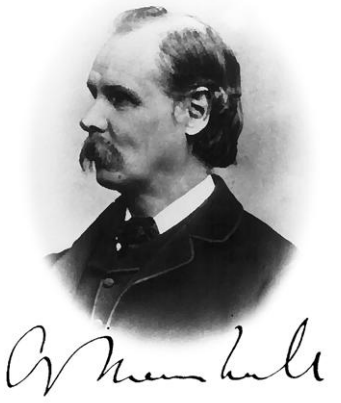

Content**Summary**

This small collection of 12 items of "Brombergiana" was deposited in the Marshall Library by Sir Geoffrey Keynes, probably fairly shortly after he had received them from Bromberg in late July 1961. It comprises Bromberg's additions to the bibliography of the works of American economist Irving Fisher and photographs of the 1961 loan exhibition in New York University Library from Bromberg's collection of books, to celebrate the 25th anniversary of the publication of Keynes's "General Theory..."

Note

Benjamin Bromberg was an American bibliophile, collector of books on economics and the history of surgery. He spent years working on a bibliography of John Maynard Keynes and also corrected the bibliography of Irving Fisher which was compiled by his son Irving Norton Fisher.

Summary	Hopes [Piero] Sraffa will have sense to display photographs [of Bromberg and J.M.Keynes's books]. Their historical value will become apparent in time. Refers to history of surgery he sent Geoffrey Keynes. He has been collecting books on history of banking for more than 20 years, buys all books on the subject. Is sending copy of his supplement to recently published bibliography of writings of Irving Fisher by his son Irving Norton Fisher. The Fisher bibliography is full of errors. Is glad he put in about 10 years' work on J.N.Keynes's bibliography before he looked at source material.
Summary	Does not expect Keynes wishes to keep his supplement. Would he present it to a library or an economist? Has sent one to Sir Roy [Harrod]. Requests Keynes to send him an inscribed copy of "Geoffrey Keynes - Tributes on the Occasion of his Seventieth Birthday" and get Heffers to invoice him.
