## Registration expiry dates

**Undergraduates** will be registered until the end of Easter Term in their final year.

**Graduate students** on taught course from Economics & Development Studies will be registered until the completion of their courses.

**Graduate students who select MPhil (Other)** will be registered until the end of Easter Term in their final year.

**PhD students who are not from Development Studies or Economics** will be registered to 6 months less than the expiry date on their card.
