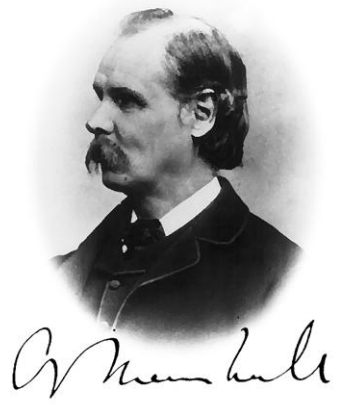

**Summary**

Supplementary material relating to Alfred and Mary Marshalls' biography and the Marshall Family, but not strictly Marshall Archives. These items have been deposited comparatively recently by members of the Guillebaud family and others, sometimes unknown. This is a very miscellaneous section of archive and photocopied material. Material relating to Alfred's life and his ancestry is placed first, followed by that relating to Mary. Anonymous economics lecture notes, some of which may have been taken at the Marshalls' lectures, are placed at the end. Within each sub-division of the section original material is placed first, photocopies at the end. There are several photocopies of Alfred's marginal notes in printed works. Other notes are known to exist in Marshall's books in the Marshall Library.
