

Records relating to teaching

This section comprises Marshall's surviving records relating to University teaching, with the exception of his lecture notes. Almost all the material relates to his teaching at Cambridge. However some early exam questions from University College Bristol are among those in 2/7. Many of the hand-written exam or essay questions have been copied by Mary Marshall. Perhaps of greatest interest are the printed forms which Marshall gave his students to fill in [Marshall 2/5], indicating which economics books they had read etc. Some of these have his annotations of essay marks or his opinion of a particular student after meeting them 'at home'. The section also includes a substantial number of printed economics or economic history exam papers collected by Marshall.
